Academic Achievement

The governors would like us to celebrate the excellent results our children have produced once again this year:

Year 1 phonics: 100% pass rate. This makes us well above national average.

Year 2 optional SATS: 90% of our children met the expected standard or exceeded this and got greater depth scores, in reading, writing and mathematics. Again, this is well above the national average.

Year 4 Multiplication Check: The school's average score was 21.3 marks out of 25. The national
